

Teen Scene

Beginning on 10/10/2023, the Teen Scene at the Olean YMCA will be a daily program that runs from 3p - 5p on school days at the Olean YMCA. It is a chance for anyone ages 10-13 to participate in structured after school sport specific activities at the Olean YMCA. Sports offerings will be on a weekly basis and will include a wide variety of offerings such as football, basketball, soccer, pickleball, volleyball, kickball, etc. Below are some important things to note regarding the program:

- 1. This will be a mandatory program for any YMCA member between the ages of 10 and 13 to remain in the building from 3p -5p on school days.
- Members will need to have a completed information packet on file at the YMCA in order to participate. These packets can be found online and at the Olean YMCA.
- 3. These packets need to be completed and returned to the front desk at the Olean YMCA or to devink@twintiersymca.org no later than 10/31/2023.
- 4. There will be no re-admittance to the program. Once a member is signed out for the day they will not be permitted to return to the program and therefore the building.

Youth Contract

The staff of the Olean YMCA is here to provide a safe and fun environment for our students. While we want everyone to enjoy themselves, certain expectations must be followed in order for safety and fun to occur here. Some offenses may not warrant a write-up but may result in loss of privileges.

Level 1 Offense: Minor infractions, such as creating a disturbance in the classroom, lying, etc.

 <u>Level 1 Intervention:</u> Youth will receive 3 verbal warnings. Youth may be sent to the lobby to await pickup

<u>Level 2 Offense:</u> Disrespectful of staff or others; failure to adhere to directions set by staff and volunteers; continued Level 1 behaviors.

• Level 2 Intervention: Conference with youth, possible suspension from the Y.

<u>Level 3 Offense:</u> Fighting, kicking, hitting, inflicting physical injury, making verbal or physical threats, inappropriate language; continued Level 2 behaviors.

• <u>Level 3 Intervention:</u> Telephone call home; conference with parent/guardian; suspension from the Y.

Suspension guideline

- 1st offense- One days suspension
- 2nd offense- Suspension the remainder of the week (or following week if incident occurs Th/Fr)
- 3rd offense- One month suspension
- 4th offense-Indefinite suspension

When a child has been admitted back into the YMCA after a suspension, and the same behaviors are repeated, the executive director will notify parent/guardian that their child's ability to enter the YMCA could be in jeopardy for the remainder of the year if such behavior is not corrected.
